HeLa Venture Camp

This unique summer school course provides students with the opportunity to experientially meet curriculum objectives for CALM 20, Physical Education 10, and CTS module options utilizing outdoor pursuits activities as the medium for the experience.

Students will have the opportunity to:

- Apply unique concepts learned through the CALM 20 and Physical Education curriculum, utilizing outdoor pursuits activities as the medium;
- Experience a variety of outdoor pursuits activities in a safe and supportive environment;
- Experience leadership from both a leader and group member perspective;
- Experience group development and team building concepts;
- Develop an understanding of care and protection of the environment;
- Develop proficiency in a variety of outdoor skills including flat and whitewater canoeing, hiking and wilderness living;
- Develop an interdependent relationship between themselves and other individuals and between themselves



Location

- HeLa Ventures Field School, located 24 km west of Rocky Mountain House.

Cost

- \$695.00 this includes transportation from Bellerose to HeLa Ventures, all meals and accommodations while at HeLa Ventures. Special dietary requirements (gluten-free, lactose-free, vegan etc.) \$35.00+GST per student. No surcharge for vegetarian or nut free diets.

Registration

- Forms to complete for this course must include the assumption of risk, medical form as well as the summer school 2017 registration form. Please print, complete and bring with birth certificate to school office to register. No online registration available.
- Each session is limited to 30 students, once the course has filled, students may be added to a wait list. Students must register or be put on a wait list – one or the other!

Dates

- **SESSION 1- JULY 3-12** (July 3-9 away at camp), **SESSION 2 - JULY 12-21** (July 15-21 away at camp)
- This is a 2 week, 11 credit course, of which 6 days are at HeLa Ventures, and the remaining days are at Bellerose, from 8-4:30
- There will be a **Parent Information Session on Wednesday, June 7, 2017 at 7pm in our school atrium** to meet the teachers and to learn important information for this course.

If you are a student already attending a school in St. Albert Public School District:

Please log into your Powerschool Parent Portal and look under suggested fees. Make sure you are selecting Bellerose! Fill in the registration form, finish by completing payment information and you are registered!

If you are a student coming to us from out of St. Albert Public School District:

Once you click on the link, you will be required to create an account by clicking the "Don't have an account?" button. You will need to use your email to complete the next step, but you will be able to choose your own password. **Please be aware that we will not be able to assist you with your password should you forget it**

Second part of the sign up is to add Out of District Student.

Once you have added your students name, it will appear at the bottom of the page under the blue bar marked Student ID. Click "Done" and it will take you to the next screen. Click on the tab in the upper left corner that has your students name on it, click the item you wish to purchase (Bellerose summer school). Once you have completed the registration process and selected your course, please proceed to the checkout . Once you have completed the check out process, you will be registered.

All HeLa registrations must be done in person at the school office. Forms to complete for this course must include the assumption of risk, medical form as well as the summer school 2017 registration form. Please print, complete and bring with birth certificate and payment to the school office to secure your spot.

Once registration has been received, a confirmation package will be sent to you at a later date with your classroom and teachers name. Please check that the demographic information is correct, complete and sign the FOIP form, provide a copy of either a birth certificate or current passport and return this package to Bellerose at your earliest convenience!
