## **Bikeathon Rules and Regulations – Here's the Deal!**

This is the 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Bikeathon! Be Proud! To be a part of this event, we expect great things from our Bellerose students! Below is what we need from you:

- 1. All participants must be enrolled at Bellerose in Semester 2 in-person learning to take part in any in-person component of this event.
- 2. School rules regarding school conduct must be followed at all times. Failure to do so will result in removal of an individual or team.
- 3. Open house is on Wednesday, March 6 from 6-8:00 pm. Each team can have only 3 members in the building from 5-9 pm to accommodate visiting parents and Grade 9 students. Each of these 3 members must stay in the village during this time. We do not want any students in the hallways during this time.
- 4. This is a Bikeathon fundraiser for cancer research and care. There must be one team member biking at ALL times during the event. Failure to keep pedaling will mean your team will give up the privilege of biking and may be removed from Bikeathon. The fact is, this is a Ride with Pride.
- 5. Each team member MUST raise a minimum of \$100 in pledges in order to participate in this event. Each team MUST raise a minimum of \$1000. Participants MUST use the official Kids with Cancer or Alberta Cancer Foundation websites.
- 6. Your team should have 8-10 members. No team member can ride for more than 2 consecutive shifts. Please sign up for time slots that you are capable of fulfilling.
- 7. Each team is responsible for providing a stationary bike to ride for the Bikeathon event. The school does NOT have bikes available to borrow.
- 8. The \$50 per person registration fee and complete registration package must be submitted in the Student Centre from Jan 15th-Feb 7th. This fee covers the cost of t-shirts, food, drinks, masks, first-aid tent, entertainment, etc. If you are paying by cheque, please make it payable to "St. Albert Public Schools 5565". This will be handed in with your completed registration packages.
- 9. Site selection is Tuesday, March 5th between 2:30 3:30 pm.
- 10. Bring your bikes on Tuesday, March 5th between 3:30 6:00 pm. Each team will be allowed one bike, which must remain on their site.

11. **a.** Team themes and outfits are expected, <u>team members are responsible for dressing appropriately</u>. Administration will not allow any inappropriate clothing or props. Prizes for themes and costumes will be awarded.

**b.** Awards and prizes will be presented to the top individual and team fundraisers at the Closing Ceremonies.

- 12. There are some considerations you must make when signing up for your shifts:
  - a. Team members with <u>spare periods</u> should make their best effort to sign up for their shifts during <u>those times</u>.
  - **b.** If you are **not** scheduled to ride during school hours, you must be in your regular scheduled class.
  - **c.** If you are missing a class due to a Bikeathon shift, you must indicate that on your ride schedule. You must also have your teacher sign off on your team ride schedule.
  - **d.** All teams must have a copy of their ride schedule submitted with their pledges on Feb 29th Mar 1st.
  - e. Your ride schedule must be accessible on your cell phone (picture) if asked by a supervisor.
  - **f.** 6 team members are allowed to stay overnight for <u>each</u> of the two nights (11pm 5am).

## 13. <u>All team members must wear their wristbands throughout the entire duration of the Bikeathon</u>.

- 14. The front doors will be locked at 9pm and reopened at 5am. Students need to be wearing the appropriate Bikeathon wristband to be in the building during this time. The appropriate overnight wristband must be worn at all times, and without it, students will not be allowed in the building.
- 15. The Annual Bellerose Bikeathon Head Shave will be held at 11:00 am on Thursday, March 7th. Proceeds from this year's event will go to the Stollery Children's Hospital Foundation. In order to be a participant in this event, permission forms must be signed by parent/guardian by Friday, March 1st. Please see Mr. Larocque if you would like to participate.
- 16. It is the responsibility of all team members to keep their site clean and litter free. Prizes will be awarded for clean sites.
- 17. We are a 'Responsible' Bikeathon Protect the school and equipment! Recycle pop cans, water bottles, and juice boxes.
- 18. Teams are responsible for the take down and clean-up of their site before leaving on Friday, March 8th.
- 19. Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in those students and their teams being withdrawn for the remainder of the event.
